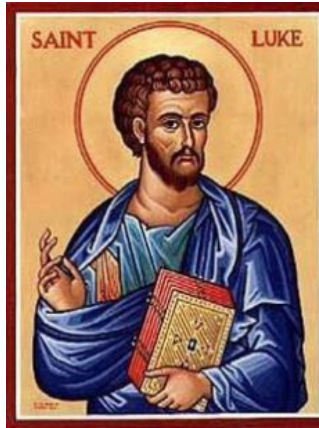

At the close of today's Gospel reading from Luke are a telling statement. After describing Jesus' journey with His Apostles and others, including some women, one of whom was Mary Magdalene, the women are portrayed as "many...who provided for them out of their resources."
