



When describing the practice of fasting and other forms of discipline or sacrificing during the season of Lent, St. Francis de Sales reminds us that in order for our efforts to be fruitful, they must be "universal", that is, our Lenten practices should affect every aspect of our lives, and not merely some aspects of it. His use of the term seems appropriate, if we recall that Francis believed that there is something of "the entire universe" contained in each one of us. In other words, on any given day there is a great deal going on within us.

He wrote the following in his Introduction to the Devout Life:

"One person sets great value on fasting and believes himself to be leading a very devout life, so long as he fasts rigorously, yet all the while his heart is full of bitterness. Another person will not moisten their lips with wine, perhaps not even with water, in their great abstinence, but does not hesitate to steep those same lips in their neighbor's blood, through slander and detraction. Still another individual reckons himself as devout because they repeat many prayers daily, although at the same time they do not refrain from all manner of angry, irritating, conceited or insulting comments among family and neighbors. Another person freely opens their purse in almsgiving but closes their heart to all gentle and forgiving feelings towards those who are opposed to them. Yet another one is ready enough to forgive their enemies but will never pay their rightful debts to others unless forced to do so. All these people may be conventionally considered 'religious', but in truth they are in no sense actually devout at all..."

Whatever fast(s) or discipline(s) we may choose to pursue during this Lenten season, may they help promote ongoing conversion not merely in some of who we are, but throughout the "universe" inside of us: body, soul, spirit, mind, heart, attitude and action!

SAFE ENVIRONMENT TRAINING

Mandatory For New Volunteers

The Diocese of Venice is committed to provide a safe environment for children and vulnerable adults. To that end, persons working with children or visiting vulnerable adults, as well as any volunteer for any ministry, are required to be finger printed (this process includes a background check) and to receive training in recognizing potential signs of abuse. The training portion can be done in your home over a PC.

For further information, visit the Diocesan website at www.dioceseofvenice.org/safeenvironment to see what is required before the parish can accept a volunteer into any ministry. Any cost a volunteer incurs to complete these requirements will be fully reimbursed on request. Report any abuse against minors to the Florida Department of Children and Families at 800-962- 2873. To report abuse by Diocesan personnel or volunteers also notify the Diocesan Victims Assistance Coordinator, Susan Benton, at (941) 416-6114.



OBLATES OF ST FRANCIS DE SALES

Lent is a time for us to encounter Jesus in a very personal way so that we deepen our baptismal consecration and commitment. John tells us that he wrote about the encounter of Jesus with the Samaritan woman so that we “may believe that Jesus is the Messiah, the Son of God, and that through this belief we may have life in his name.”

Notice that, during this encounter, Jesus is drawing the woman beyond earthly realities and concerns to the deeper realities of the eternal. Jesus offers her “living water.” He means water that gives life, but her attention is on earthly water. She asks him, rather sarcastically, if he thinks he’s better than Jacob who gave them this well. Jesus refuses to be side-tracked from his goal - to give her water that will permanently end her thirst. All she can see is the convenience of not having to come to the well every day.

Jesus moves her to a new level by getting her to face the truth of her present situation. But he doesn’t tell her to “come back when you’ve straightened out your life.” The grace he offers is meant to help her to change – here and now.

Rather than make a commitment now, she says that she’s waiting for the Messiah to come. Now, Jesus can offer her the opportunity for a personal commitment: “I am he.”

The purpose of the story is to remind us that even committed disciples need to be brought to deeper understanding and conversion.

How great is our thirst during this Lenten season? What is the “food” we are seeking? What is it that Jesus wants us to understand through our Lenten encounters with him? St. Paul reminds us that God has proven his love for us. While we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

Our Lenten journey will be more fruitful if we are sincerely open when we encounter Jesus and are willing to be led by grace into a deeper conversion of mind and heart to the ways of the Lord. Then our hope will be based on the love of God poured out into our hearts.
