

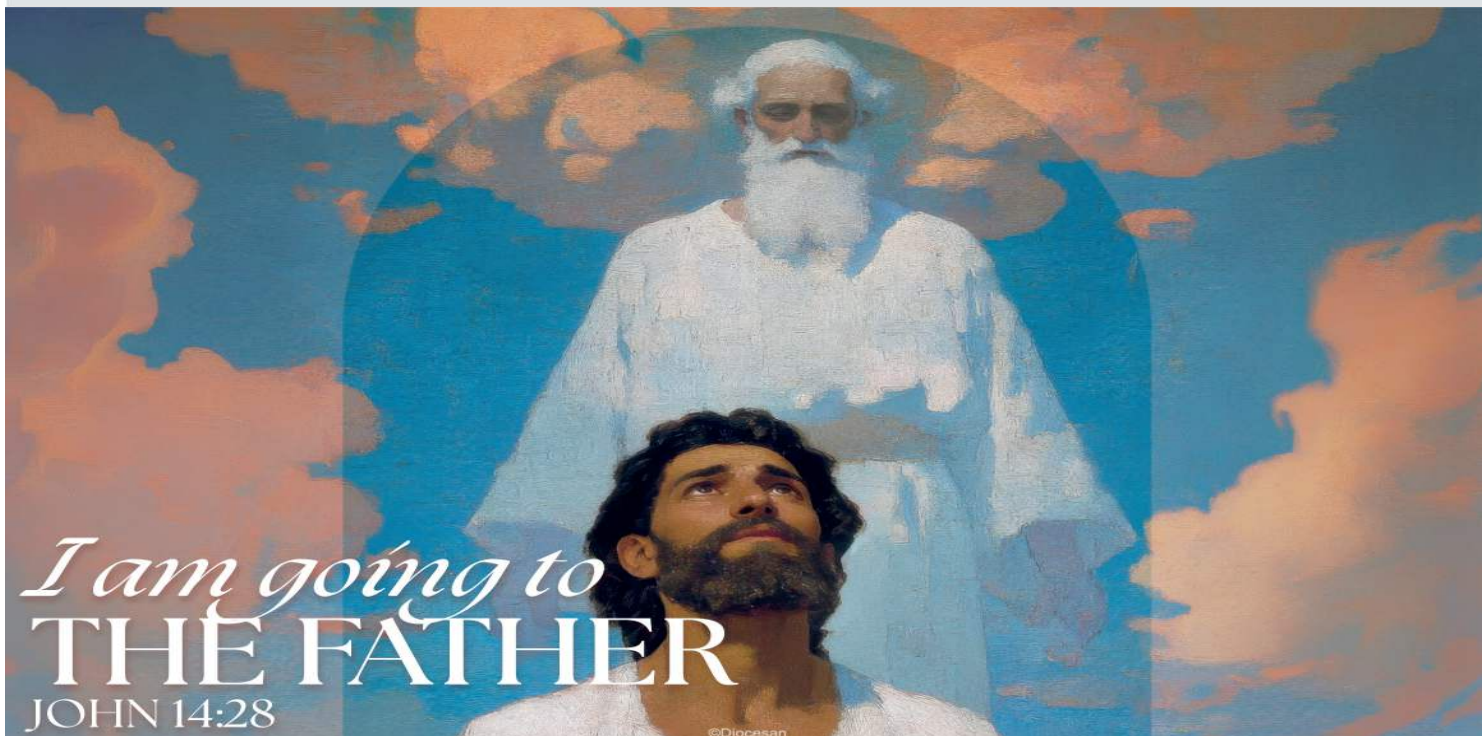

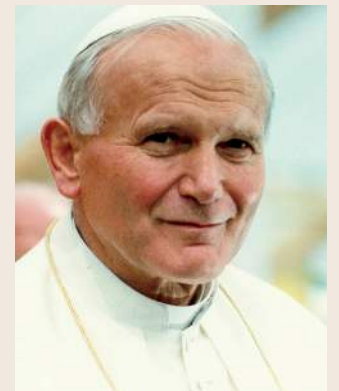

## Celebrating the Lord's Day Part III: Keeping Sunday - All day

Celebrating the Sunday Eucharist—though central and essential—does not complete our observance of Sunday. In addition to attending Mass each Sunday, we should also refrain “from those activities which impede the worship of God and disturb the joy proper to the day of the Lord or the necessary relaxation of mind and body” (Compendium of the Catechism of the Catholic Church, no. 453).

Sunday has traditionally been a day of rest. However, the concept of a day of rest may seem odd in a world that runs 24/7, where we are tethered to our jobs by a variety of electronic gadgets, where businesses run as normal no matter what the day of the week, and where silence seems to be an endangered species. By taking a day each week to rest in the Lord, we provide a living example to the culture that all time belongs to God and that people are more important than things.

As Pope John Paul II said in *Dies Domini* (The Day of the Lord), his apostolic letter on Sunday:

"Through Sunday rest, daily concerns and tasks can find their proper perspective: the material things about which we worry give way to spiritual values; in a moment of encounter and less pressured exchange, we see the true face of the people with whom we live. Even the beauties of nature—too often marred by the desire to exploit, which turns against man himself—can be rediscovered and enjoyed to the full. "

## SAFE ENVIRONMENT TRAINING

### *Mandatory For New Volunteers*

The Diocese of Venice is committed to provide a safe environment for children and vulnerable adults. To that end, persons working with children or visiting vulnerable adults, as well as any volunteer for any ministry, are required to be finger printed (this process includes a background check) and to receive training in recognizing potential signs of abuse. The training portion can be done in your home over a PC.

**OBLATES OF  
ST FRANCIS DE SALES**

Today Jesus implores us to believe in Him. He is the life-giving Truth who gives us strength to do great works. St. Francis de Sales notes:

There is nothing stronger than truth. To live in truth is to lead a life entirely conformed to simple faith. So great is the strength of faith that it fears nothing. People indeed have this strength of faith. Yet, because we do not always realize that this is in us, we often fear and become weak. The strength of faith consists partly in knowing its power that says we can do everything in God who strengthens us. Our strength of faith has us acknowledge the truth of our goodness and dignity as persons who are capable of being united to God, who is Truth. Our faith in being united to God sustains us amidst so many great weaknesses, and gives us strength to become authentic persons.

The aim of Christian authenticity is to transcend our own self-centered spirit and find our true spirit in Christ. Our Lord came into this world to give us life. Yet, as long as we live, we will have some self-seeking interests that deny us His life-giving way. Little by little, let us leave our affections of these lesser things and aspire to the happiness that God desires for us. The greater fervor we have in letting go of lesser loves, the more God's love can do great works in us. The more we let go of our selfish desires and yield to God's desire for us, the more our human spirit will be free from interior restlessness.

Bees are restless while they are without a queen. We too are restless until we give birth to Our Savior in our hearts. Let us remain very near to this sacred Savior who gathers us all around Himself so as to keep us always under His most holy protection. He is like the queen bee that cares so much for her swarm she never leaves her hive without being surrounded by all her little people. Great is the confidence that Our Redeemer wants us to place in His care for us. All who trust in Him always reap the fruits of this confidence. Imitating His truthful, life-giving way has us do great works indeed!

# Opening Ourselves to Freedom

Excerpt from "The Mindful Catholic"

even more tightly.

This is a good image for what happens when you try to solve problems in your life with the doing mind instead of beginning from a place of trusting entirely in God. As you wrestle through a situation trying to come up with a solution, your brain is firing away as you are in danger, and this in turn narrows your sense of creativity. Creativity is an essential element in problem solving, but it doesn't work very well when anxiety is increasing. This is also why people will often "sleep on it" when trying to figure out a problem or break through a writer's block. Letting the problem go for a time is like releasing your fingers from the constricting grasp of the finger trap. If you relax and stop the fight to free your fingers, the tube lets go and you can slip them out. When you let go of the idea that something is a "problem" that needs to be figured out, your brain relaxes the doing mode and you can open up to solutions you never thought possible[...]



Sometimes we become frantic when we don't know what we are supposed to do. Discernment is a process that requires gentle peacefulness, and we need to slow down in order to hear the voice of God. In the Old Testament, Elijah met God in the "still, small voice" of a gentle breeze; God was not in the storms. We allow those storms to rage in our minds and hearts and we grow even more disquiet when we can't figure out where God is in the midst of it all. This is why St. Therese said she would "let Jesus sleep peacefully within her little boat" no matter how bad the storm got or how much the waves crashed. She knew there was peace to be found in that storm, and she could simply quiet her soul knowing Jesus would take care of it if he needed to. This peace is necessary for you to be able to truly hear the voice of God. This interior quiet is the fruit of learning how to slow down and let your mind settle into the reality of the present moment instead of looking for God in the midst of the frantic thoughts and feelings.

In *Searching for and Maintaining Peace*, Fr. Jacques Philippe writes:



*Often we become agitated and disturbed by trying to resolve everything by ourselves, when it would be more efficacious to remain peacefully before the gaze of God and to allow Him to act and work in us with His wisdom and power, which are infinitely superior to ours. This doesn't mean that we should be lazy or inactive. Trusting God is courageously and powerfully active. This is an invitation to act, even to a tiresome level at times, under the impulse of the Holy Spirit. This is not a spirit of inquietude, agitation, or excessive hurry, which is too often the case with us and the way we want to be active."*

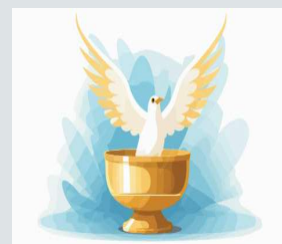
