# WELCOME

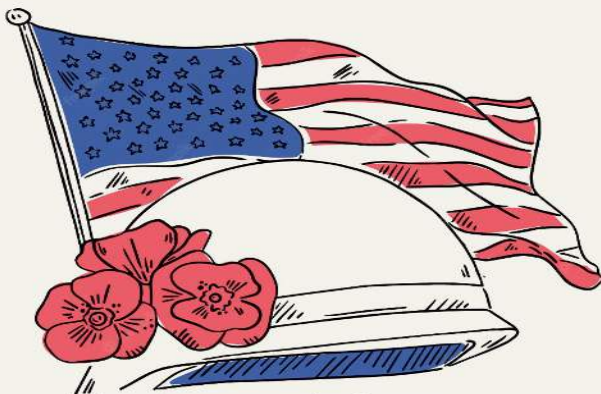

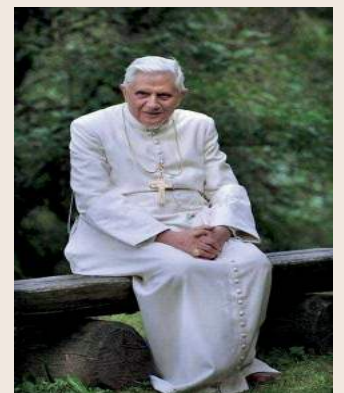

## Pentecost

The story goes:

40 days after the resurrection (which we celebrate at Easter), Jesus ascends into heaven (which we celebrate on Ascension Day). But before he ascends, Jesus promises that he will not leave us "comfortless" but will send the Holy Spirit to strengthen and to guide us, and to guide the church.

Ten days later, on the Day of Pentecost, the Holy Spirit descended on the people gathered. Note that Pentecost is an ancient Jewish festival of the harvest, the name of which translates from the Hebrew as The Festival of Weeks. This festival is referred to in Exodus chapters 23 ad 34 and in Deuteronomy chapter 16.

In the Book of Acts, the story is told:

*And when the day of Pentecost was fully come, they were all with one accord in one place. And suddenly there came a sound from heaven as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled all the house where they were sitting. And there appeared unto them cloven tongues like as of fire, and it sat upon each of them. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit, and began to speak with other languages, as the Spirit gave them utterance. And there were dwelling at Jerusalem Jews, devout men, out of every nation under heaven. Now when this was noised abroad, the multitudes came together, and were confounded, because that every man heard them speak in his own language. (Acts 2:1-6)*

So... on The Day of Pentecost in the church year, forty days of Easter and ten days after the Ascension, the clergy wear **RED** vestments to signify the work of the Spirit. It is also a custom in many churches for the people in the congregation to wear **RED** on the Day of Pentecost as well. We wear **RED** to remind us of the fire of the Spirit. In addition, a congregation with many dressed in **RED** is colorful. And perhaps most of all, it is fun!

SCIENCE is simply the same love keeping us attentive to know ourselves and creatures to obtain a more perfect knowledge of the service we owe to God.

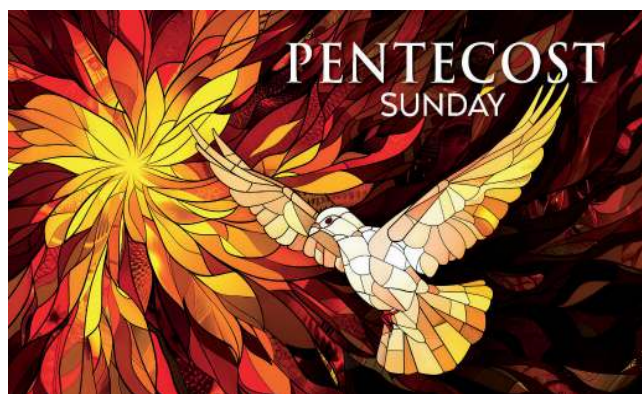
COUNSEL is also love, as it renders us careful attentive and skilled in choosing the means proper to serve God in a holy manner.

## SAFE ENVIRONMENT TRAINING

*Mandatory For New Volunteers*

The Diocese of Venice is committed to provide a safe environment for children and vulnerable adults. To that end, persons working with children or visiting vulnerable adults, as well as any volunteer for any ministry, are required to be finger printed (this process includes a background check) and to receive training in recognizing potential signs of abuse. The training portion can be done in your home over a PC.

Any cost a volunteer incurs to complete these requirements will be fully reimbursed on request. Report any abuse against minors to the Florida Department of Children and Families at 800-962-2873. # SINGERS OF GRACE

## BY: POPE LEO XIV

(EXCERPTS FROM HOMILY OF NOV. 23, 2025)



Great civilizations have given us the gift of music in order to express what we carry deep in our hearts and what words cannot always convey. Music can give expression to the whole range of feelings and emotions that arise within us from a living relationship with reality. Singing, in particular, constitutes a natural and refined expression of the human being: mind, feelings, body and soul come together to communicate the great events of life. As Saint Augustine reminded us: "Cantare amantis est" (cf. Sermo 336,1), that is, "singing belongs to those who love." Those who sing give expression to love, but also to the pain, tenderness and desire that dwell in their hearts, while at the same time, loving those to whom they address their song (cf. Enarrationes in Psalmos, 72,1).



For the people of God, song expresses invocation and praise. It is the "new song" that the Risen Christ raises to the Father, in which all the baptized participate as one body animated by the new life of the Spirit. In Christ, we become singers of grace, children of the Church who discover in the Risen One the cause of our praise. Liturgical music thus becomes a precious instrument through which we carry out our service of praise to God and express the joy of new life in Christ.

You belong to choirs that carry out their ministry primarily in liturgical settings. Yours is a true ministry that requires preparation, commitment, mutual understanding and, above all, a deep spiritual life, so that when you sing, you both pray and help everyone else to pray. This ministry requires discipline and a spirit of service, especially when preparing for a solemn liturgy or an important event in your communities. The choir is a small family of individuals united by their love of music and the service they offer. However, remember that the community is your larger family. You are not on stage, but rather a part of that community, endeavoring to help it grow in unity by inspiring and engaging its members. As in all families, tensions or minor misunderstandings can arise. These things are normal when working together and striving to achieve a goal. We can say to some extent that the choir symbolizes of the Church, which, striving toward its goal, walks through history praising God. Even when this journey is beset by difficulties and trials and joyful moments give way to more challenging ones, singing makes the journey lighter, providing relief and consolation...



I place all of you under the protection of Saint Cecilia, the virgin and martyr who raised the most beautiful song of love through her life here in Rome, giving herself entirely to Christ and offering the Church a shining example of faith and love.

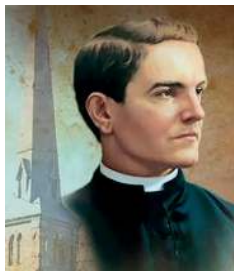

# Knights of Columbus

## THE KNIGHT'S CORNER

Recently, Brian Caulfied, Vice Postulator of Father McGivney Guild wrote about our formation.



April 1882 was an excellent month for Father McGivney and the Knights of Columbus. Just days after the Connecticut legislature approved the Order's charter on March 29, the first induction ceremony was held in New Haven, and a letter was sent to pastors throughout the state announcing the formation of the new society.

"Our primary object," Father McGivney wrote, "is to prevent our people from entering secret societies, by offering the same if not better, advantages to our members. Secondly, to unite the men of our Faith throughout the Diocese of Hartford, that we may thereby gain strength to aid each other in time of sickness; to provide for decent burial, and to render pecuniary assistance to the families of deceased members."

He goes on to describe membership benefits and laments the great number of Catholic men who were joining anti-Catholic fraternal groups because there were no comparable Catholic Societies working to protect the faith and finances of their families.

The letter is an amazing testament to Father McGivney's vision and mission. Far from being the dusty words of a 19th century founder, the letter shows the well-developed plans that still animate the Knights of Columbus today. Clearly, he was a man ahead of his time who speaks to our modern age.

Blessed Michael McGivney, pray for us.
