## Ten Qualities for Holy Living (Part 2)

Practical Paths to Holiness By: The Oblates of St. Francis de Sales

**Fourth, be patient.** Wanting things too quickly can be counterproductive. Be patient with yourself and with others. Take things as they come. St. Jane de Chantal observes that anything "borne quietly and patiently is a continual, very powerful prayer before God."

**Fifth, live in the present.** Don't dwell in the past. Don't obsess about the future. Carpe diem, that is, seize today, master the moment! "To advance well," St. Francis de Sales says, "we must apply ourselves to make good way on the road nearest to us, and to do today's journey."

**Sixth, roll with the punches.** Pick your battles. Be steadfast on principle, but flexible in detail. "Blessed are hearts that bend," observes St. Francis de Sales, "they will never break."

**Seventh, do little, simple things well.** Why wait for some one-time opportunity to do a great thing and risk missing countless opportunities each day to perform simpler ones with great attention, passion, and zeal? "We cannot always offer God great things, says St. Jane de Chantal, "but at each instant, we can offer little things with great love."

**Eighth, remain focused on your own happiness, health, and holiness.** You can't give what you don't have. We can be so concerned about others' welfare that we neglect our own. St. Francis de Sales cautions us: "Do not sow crops of good intentions in your neighbor's garden; rather, cultivate your own."

**Ninth, strive for balance.** Avoid extremes. "Salt and sugar are both excellent things," claims St. Francis de Sales, "but too much of either spoils the dish." Food for thought.

**Finally, make and maintain good friendships.** Don't be a lone ranger. Seek out others in friendship who can support you, encourage you, understand you, and challenge you in your desire to grow in happiness, health, and holiness. The book of Sirach (6:16) says it best: "A faithful friend is the medicine of life and of immortality."

## SAFE ENVIRONMENT TRAINING

### Mandatory For New Volunteers

The Diocese of Venice is committed to provide a safe environment for children and vulnerable adults. To that end, persons working with children or visiting vulnerable adults, as well as any volunteer for any ministry, are required to be finger printed (this process includes a background check) and to receive training in recognizing potential signs of abuse. The training portion can be done in your home over a PC.

# STATEMENT FROM SAINT CECILIA'S OBLATES OF SAINT FRANCIS DE SALES



Saint Francis de Sales, in giving a conference to the Sisters of the Visitation on an occasion when some sisters were leaving to begin a new foundation (#16) said: **"On leaving one another, I have thought that I ought to say some small thing which might lessen this grief. I also don't want to say that you cannot cry a little, for you ought to do that seeing that it cannot be otherwise, having lived so gently and lovingly together for such a long time ... [but] you will not be divided or separated at all, for everyone will go away and everyone will remain. Those who go away stay and those who stay go away. Those who stay go away, not in their very person, but in the persons of those who go away; and likewise, those who go away remain in the persons of those who will remain..."**

As the Oblates withdraw from ministry in Florida and Frs. Frank and Paul depart from our Saint Cecilia Catholic Community, our hearts remain united and Salesian Spirituality has been imbued within the living stones of this holy temple and that is the Oblate legacy. Fr. Frank is moving to Wilmington, Delaware (1801 N. Broom St., Wilmington, DE, 19802) and will minister at local parishes while living in the Oblate Residence at our Salesianum High School. Fr. Paul will be going to CA for two months and then, after Labor Day, he will become the superior at Oblate Retirement Community at the former Oblate Novitiate and shrine of Our Lady of the Highways (adjacent to I95) in Childs, MD (PO Box 43, Childs, MD 21916).

We have not been informed who will be succeeding the Oblates in the parish. We will miss you and ask for your continued prayers that we may all Live Jesus by being docile to the will of God and charitably and humbly journeying together on the Way.
