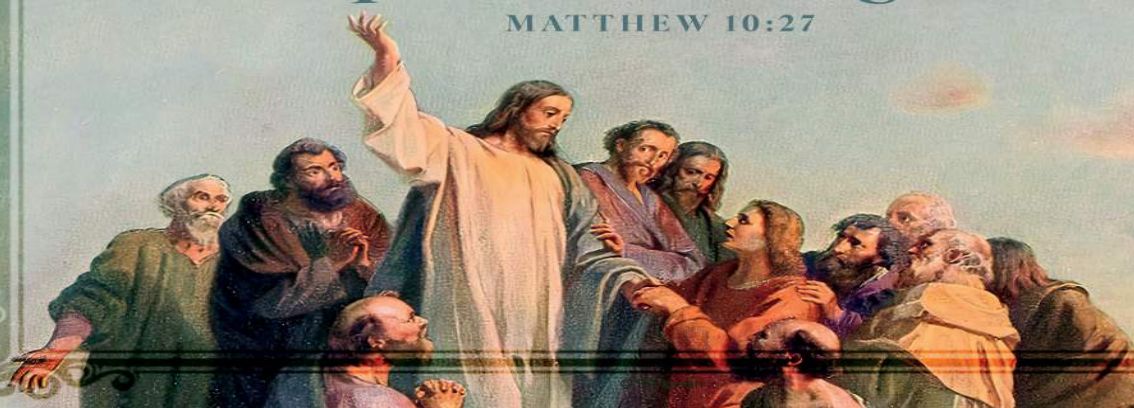

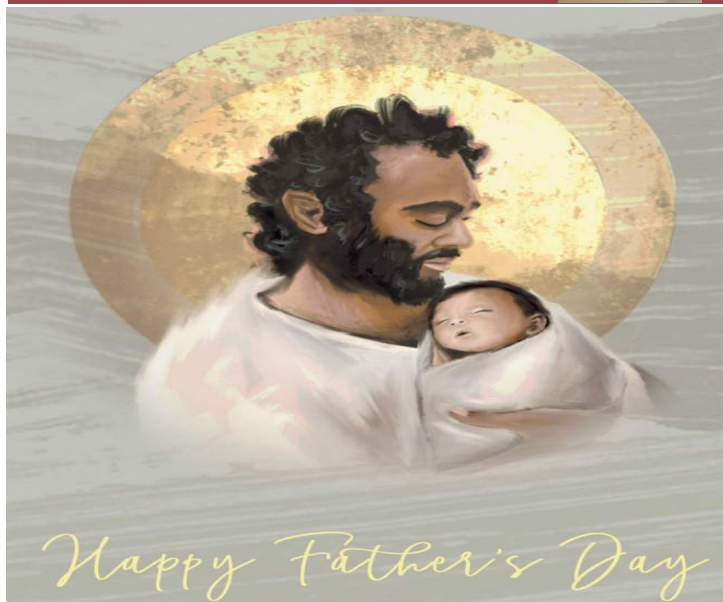
WELCOME

The Paradox of Faith

“Do not fear men,” Jesus says. He is talking about fearing those who persecute you for your faith. In the verses preceding this Gospel passage, he tries to prepare us for persecution and says that just as people did to him (Jesus), they would do to his followers. But he triumphed over his persecutors. They could not stop him. And that is what he promises us as well. We cannot be destroyed as long as we hold on to that faith.

The best way to maintain faith is to share it with others. It sounds like a contradiction, but it means that when we spread faith, our faith grows as well. And when we allow others to share their faith with us, we feel encouraged and supported.

Sometimes we may hesitate when speaking about faith. The only thing we should fear is our weakness, not Satan's power. That's why Jesus said that whoever denies him before men, he will also deny him. However, Jesus died for our sins, so not even they can destroy us if we turn to the Lord. So thank Him for His forgiveness, but don't forget to spread the news that you have been forgiven. You might encourage someone else to have the courage to return to the Lord, and thus achieve another victory of faith that overcomes fear.

**OBLATES OF
ST FRANCIS DE SALES**

In today's Gospel, Jesus tells us to fear those who try to destroy our souls and to place our trust in God who cares for us. St. Francis de Sales notes:

Everyone desires to embrace the good and fly from what is evil. When we experience an evil, we become sad and desire to free ourselves of this sadness. We are right to seek a means to get rid of this sadness. Fear and anxiety can come from an inordinate desire to be freed from a present difficulty or to realize a hoped for goal.

Whenever you urgently hope to realize a certain good or to escape from a certain uneasiness, you must be especially careful to put your mind at rest and be at peace. When you see that you are becoming anxious, place yourself in God's presence. Resolve to do nothing that your desire insists on until your mind has regained peace. Be careful to make calm judgments based on the authentic values found in Jesus' teachings. Then try, without hurry, trouble, or anxiety, to accomplish your desire. Perform the action, not according to your desire, but reason

When we seek to escape from our troubles, we must do so patiently, gently, and calmly. We must look to God for help rather than our own efforts. If we look to ourselves only, we will wear ourselves out. Walk simply in the way our Lord shows you and don't worry. Sing songs of praise and thanksgiving. Involve yourself in a variety of healthful activities. Also, revealing the cause of your anxiety to your confessor or a reliable person empowers you to find relief. If we always tend toward God's love, neither tribulation nor fear of future troubles will separate us from this love. Our love is founded on Jesus Christ, who cares for us and never betrays us. Great indeed is the confidence our Savior wants us to have in His care. All who trust in this confidence reap great fruit.

SAFE ENVIRONMENT TRAINING

Mandatory For New Volunteers

The Diocese of Venice is committed to provide a safe environment for children and vulnerable adults. To that end, persons working with children or visiting vulnerable adults, as well as any volunteer for any ministry, are required to be finger printed (this process includes a background check) and to receive training in recognizing potential signs of abuse. The training portion can be done in your home over a PC.



For further information, visit the Diocesan website at www.dioceseofvenice.org/safeenvironment to see what is required before the parish can accept a volunteer into any ministry. Any cost a volunteer incurs to complete these requirements will be fully reimbursed on request.

STATEMENT FROM SAINT CECILIA'S OBLATES OF SAINT FRANCIS DE SALES



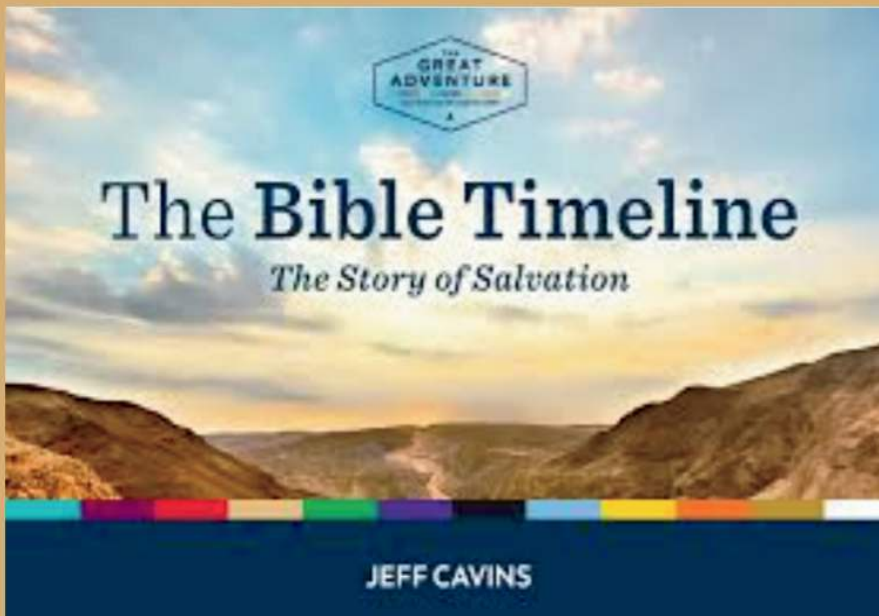
Saint Francis de Sales, in giving a conference to the Sisters of the Visitation on an occasion when some sisters were leaving to begin a new foundation (#16) said: **"On leaving one another, I have thought that I ought to say some small thing which might lessen this grief. I also don't want to say that you cannot cry a little, for you ought to do that seeing that it cannot be otherwise, having lived so gently and lovingly together for such a long time ... [but] you will not be divided or separated at all, for everyone will go away and everyone will remain. Those who go away stay and those who stay go away. Those who stay go away, not in their very person, but in the persons of those who go away; and likewise, those who go away remain in the persons of those who will remain..."**

As the Oblates withdraw from ministry in Florida and Frs. Frank and Paul depart from our Saint Cecilia Catholic Community, our hearts remain united and Salesian Spirituality has been imbued within the living stones of this holy temple and that is the Oblate legacy. Fr. Frank is moving to Wilmington, Delaware (1801 N. Broom St., Wilmington, DE, 19802) and will minister at local parishes while living in the Oblate Residence at our Salesianum High School. Fr. Paul will be going to CA for two months and then, after Labor Day, he will become the superior at Oblate Retirement Community at the former Oblate Novitiate and shrine of Our Lady of the Highways (adjacent to I95) in Childs, MD (PO Box 43, Childs, MD 21916).

We have not been informed who will be succeeding the Oblates in the parish. We will miss you and ask for your continued prayers that we may all Live Jesus by being docile to the will of God and charitably and humbly journeying together on the Way.

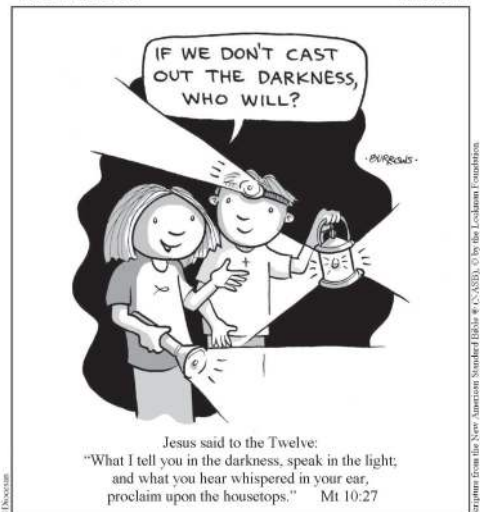
