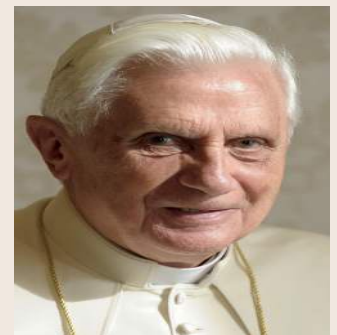

Key to the City

When an important person visits a city, sometimes the mayor presents him with the key to the city as a sign of welcome; or sometimes a key is given to a citizen who has provided exemplary service to the community. In today's Gospel, Jesus gives Simon the keys to the kingdom of heaven and gives him a new name, Peter. This is more than a symbolic honor bestowed by a mayor. Jesus is giving him both a blessing and a responsibility.

The blessing is that Peter recognized Jesus as the Son of God. It was a blessing because Peter did so, not by his own intelligence or the help of other disciples, but with faith, a gift from God the Father. Even today, people are blessed with this kind of faith. An atheist who has heard of Jesus but considers him just another holy man can receive faith and recognize Jesus as the Son of God. A person who withdraws from others and cares only for themselves can find the faith to see Jesus in those around them. A sick person can see that Jesus is with them in their suffering and begin to have hope. The faith that sees Jesus in others is the rock upon which Jesus builds his Church. It is also the "crown of righteousness" that St. Paul says belongs to all who long to see Jesus (2 Timothy 4:18).

Responsibility comes in binding and losing. One meaning of this is the power Jesus gives his Church to forgive sins. Jesus forgave many sinners, sometimes even before they asked. He knew they desired forgiveness in their hearts, even though they may not have dared to ask for it. He even forgave those who crucified him (Luke 23:34). Those who follow Jesus have the same obligation to forgive others. If we forgive those who hurt us, they may come to see God's love in us and know that God will forgive them too. On the other hand, if we refuse to forgive, we could push someone away from seeking God's forgiveness. That doesn't mean we are responsible for how others react to us. But why pass up the opportunity to show God's love by forgiving someone? All Christians pray in the Lord's Prayer that we may be forgiven as we forgive others. Let us use the keys of the kingdom to open the doors of God's love.

**OBLATES OF
ST FRANCIS DE SALES**

In today's Gospel Jesus tells us how we must love Him if we are to be His disciples. St. Francis de Sales notes:

God willed that Adam should love Eve tenderly, yet not so tenderly that to please her he should violate the command God had given him. Love of our family, friends, and benefactors is what God desires. Yet, we can love them to excess. This also may be the case with our vocation, no matter how spiritual, and even with our devotions, when we love them as if they were our last end. We must remind ourselves that they are only a means to our final intention, which is love of God.

Why does our excessive love of persons and things arise? It arises because the very things we ought to love according to God's Will, we love for other causes and motives. These motives may not be contrary to God but are apart from God. That is, they focus more on our desires than what God desires for us.

Yet, there are souls who love only that what God wills and whatever way God wills it for them. These souls are truly blessed for they love God, love their friends in God, and even love their enemies for God. It is God whom they love not only above all things, but even in all things. Rare and singular are these souls. They are like pearl fishermen who do not say they are fishing for oysters but rather for pearls. These great souls find the pearl of God's loving presence in all persons and things, and this is the cause of their joy.

In today's Gospel Jesus urges us to love, as God desires us to love. To will what God wills for us, we must let go of all that is not of God in our desires and affections. Then we are free to love all persons and things in Christ and for Christ. It is the presence of Christ's divine love in us that empowers us to become His disciples.

SAFE ENVIRONMENT TRAINING

Mandatory For New Volunteers

The Diocese of Venice is committed to provide a safe environment for children and vulnerable adults. To that end, persons working with children or visiting vulnerable adults, as well as any volunteer for any ministry, are required to be finger printed (this process includes a background check) and to receive training in recognizing potential signs of abuse. The training portion can be done in your home over a PC.



For further information, visit the Diocesan website at www.dioceseofvenice.org/safeenvironment to see what is required before the parish can accept a volunteer into any ministry. Any cost a volunteer incurs to complete these requirements will be fully reimbursed on request.

TRIBUTE TO THE OBLATES OF SAINT FRANCIS DE SALES

“Well done, my good and faithful servant. Since you were faithful in small matters, I will give you great responsibilities. Come, share your master’s joy.” – Matthew 25:21

I cannot think of a more appropriate Scripture verse to honor and pay tribute to the Oblates of Saint Francis de Sales and in particular to Fathers Paul Dechant and Frank Hanlon. Not only have they been faithful in seemingly small matters, but great matters as well “LIVING JESUS” day in and day out.

There is another Scripture passage that speaks of their years of service, not only at and with the Saint Cecilia Catholic Community, but from Profession to Ordination and throughout their many years of ministry. The passage is found in the Gospel of John, 21:15-17. Jesus questions “Simon, son of John” asking him if he loves Jesus, not once, but three times. And each time Simon Peter responds with his “yes” Jesus gives him a command: “Feed my lambs.” “Tend my sheep.” “Feed my sheep.”

The Catholic Composer, Rory Cooney, married this passage to Psalm 23 and composed one of my favorite hymns. Not only did I use it for my Mass of Thanksgiving before I left Ohio for my new home and life in Fort Myers and Saint Cecilia, but intend to have it used at my Funeral Mass. The refrain is: ***“If you love me, feed my lambs; Be my heart, my voice, my hands. If you love me, feed my sheep. And for my part, I give you the heart of a shepherd.”***

On June 11th, the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops *consecrated* the United States of America to the Sacred Heart of Jesus on the occasion of the upcoming 250th Anniversary of the Signing of the Declaration of Independence. A passionate desire on the part of the Bishops and countless others that OUR hearts might be united with the Sacred Heart of Jesus.

For years, the Oblates of Saint Francis de Sales, and in particular, Fathers Paul and Frank, have made it a priority to unite their hearts more closely to the Sacred Heart of Jesus so that He might take over their hearts giving them “the heart of a shepherd” and being His voice and becoming His hands, always with the desire of loving and feeding those entrusted to their care.

I, along with all of us in this Catholic Community who have been, are, and will be, are grateful for their constant “yes” and their goodness and faithfulness in “LIVING JESUS”. As Saint Francis de Sales is reported to have said, “Be who you are and be that well.”

Fathers Paul and Frank have done just that. May we, together, join our voices in asking the Lord to let these shepherds know, “Well done good and faithful servant[s]. [May you both] continue to share your master’s joy.”

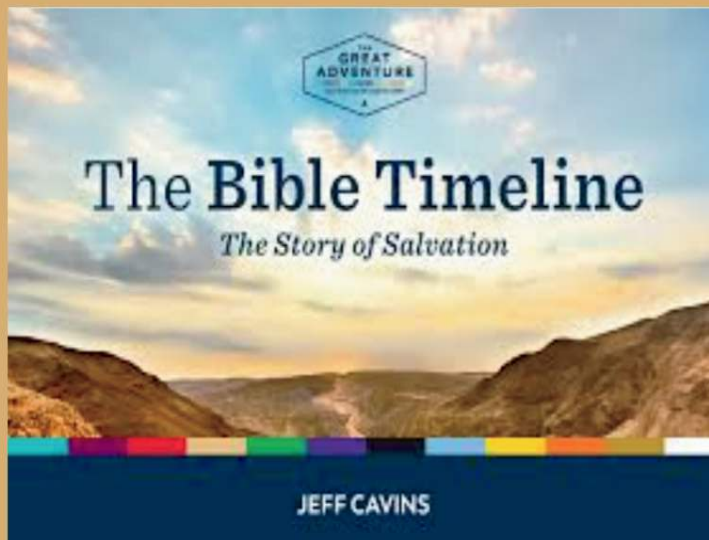
