SAFE ENVIRONMENT TRAINING

Mandatory For New Volunteers

The Diocese of Venice is committed to provide a safe environment for children and vulnerable adults. To that end, persons working with children or visiting vulnerable adults, as well as any volunteer for any ministry, are required to be finger printed (this process includes a background check) and to receive training in recognizing potential signs of abuse. The training portion can be done in your home over a PC.

For further information, visit the Diocesan website at www.dioceseofvenice.org/safeenvironment to see what is required before the parish can accept a volunteer into any ministry. Any cost a volunteer incurs to complete these requirements will be fully reimbursed on request. Report any abuse against minors to the Florida Department of Children and Families at 800-962-2873. To report abuse by Diocesan personnel or volunteers, notify the Diocesan Victims Assistance Coordinator, Susan Benton, at (941) 416-6114.

"The quality of mercy is not strained..."

The Consensus Statement shared by all of the Congregations of St. Joseph says:

"...It droppeth as the gentle rain from heaven
Upon the place beneath. . .
It is an attribute of God himself;
And earthly power doth then show likest God's
When mercy seasons justice."
--The Merchant of Venice, Act IV, Scene I



I suspect that the most well known commentary on mercy comes from William Shakespeare as quoted here. The quality of mercy is not strained, forced, nor demanded, but is freely given; indeed, a gift to the one who receives mercy. Thus, mercy is best understood by one who has received another's mercy in some way.

According to the Bible, the people of ancient Israel experienced the mercy of God time and again. The Hebrew word, *hesed*, is often translated as mercy, but that is too general a definition. *Hesed* is rooted in relationship, and refers to God's faithfulness, God's commitment to keep the covenant. When Israel sins and breaks the covenant, God is released from the obligation of covenant; but it is **mercy** by which God remains faithful.

We might conclude then that mercy is the source of care, of loving kindness, of forgiveness, of compassion when it is unearned or undeserved. Mercy is a quality of humanity at its best. And most certainly a virtue for all who are baptized into Jesus Christ.



The Scriptures often reflect on God's mercy, as in Psalm 145:8: "The Lord is gracious and merciful, slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love." The book of Hosea is an allegory in which Hosea remains faithful--

and thus merciful to his unfaithful wife, Gomer. In Matthew's Gospel, 9:13, God says: "I desire mercy and not sacrifice." Acts of mercy seem more pleasing to God than ritual acts of sacrifice. In Chapter 6 of Luke's Gospel, Jesus teaches that those who act with mercy are indeed children of God, who "is kind to the ungrateful and the selfish. Be merciful as your God is merciful." A little later in Luke's Gospel, Chapter 15, we hear the story of the merciful father, who welcomes home his prodigal son as a touching example of great and unexpected mercy.

In his book, *Friendship and the Moral Life*, Paul Wadell suggests that we learn life skills NOT from laws and guidelines, but from the model of those basic communities with whom we share life. Thus, we learn mercy by observing mercy.

Pope Francis himself picks up on the sign value of mercy in his declaration of a Year of Mercy for the Church. He said: "...rediscover the richness encompassed by the spiritual and corporal works of mercy. The experience of mercy becomes visible in the witness of concrete signs as Jesus himself taught us."



And so we reflect on a time or times when we have observed mercy, been treated with mercy, or been conscious of choosing to be merciful rather than judgmental. Some stories of mercy are quite simple, but leave

lasting impact: like the girls' championship softball game where a batter hit a home run to win the game. But, she tore a knee ligament at first base and could not move. The umpires warned her team that if she were touched, the home run would be null and void; or if there were a pinch runner, the home run would become a single. The opposing team's pitcher and catcher went to their opponent on first base and carried her around the bases to complete the run that won the game!

Many of our CSJ Ministries serve the dear neighbor with mercy, not just delivering a service that is needed, but recognizing the relationship that is the foundation of mercy.

In common use, mercy may be seen as the opposite of "an eye for an eye" but in reality it is much, much more. The merciful person is an image of God, recognizes the relationship with all as brother or sister, the dear neighbor, and is ever called upon to show mercy. I submit that to be merciful is indeed to be "stimulated by the Holy Spirit of love and attentive to her inspirations."
